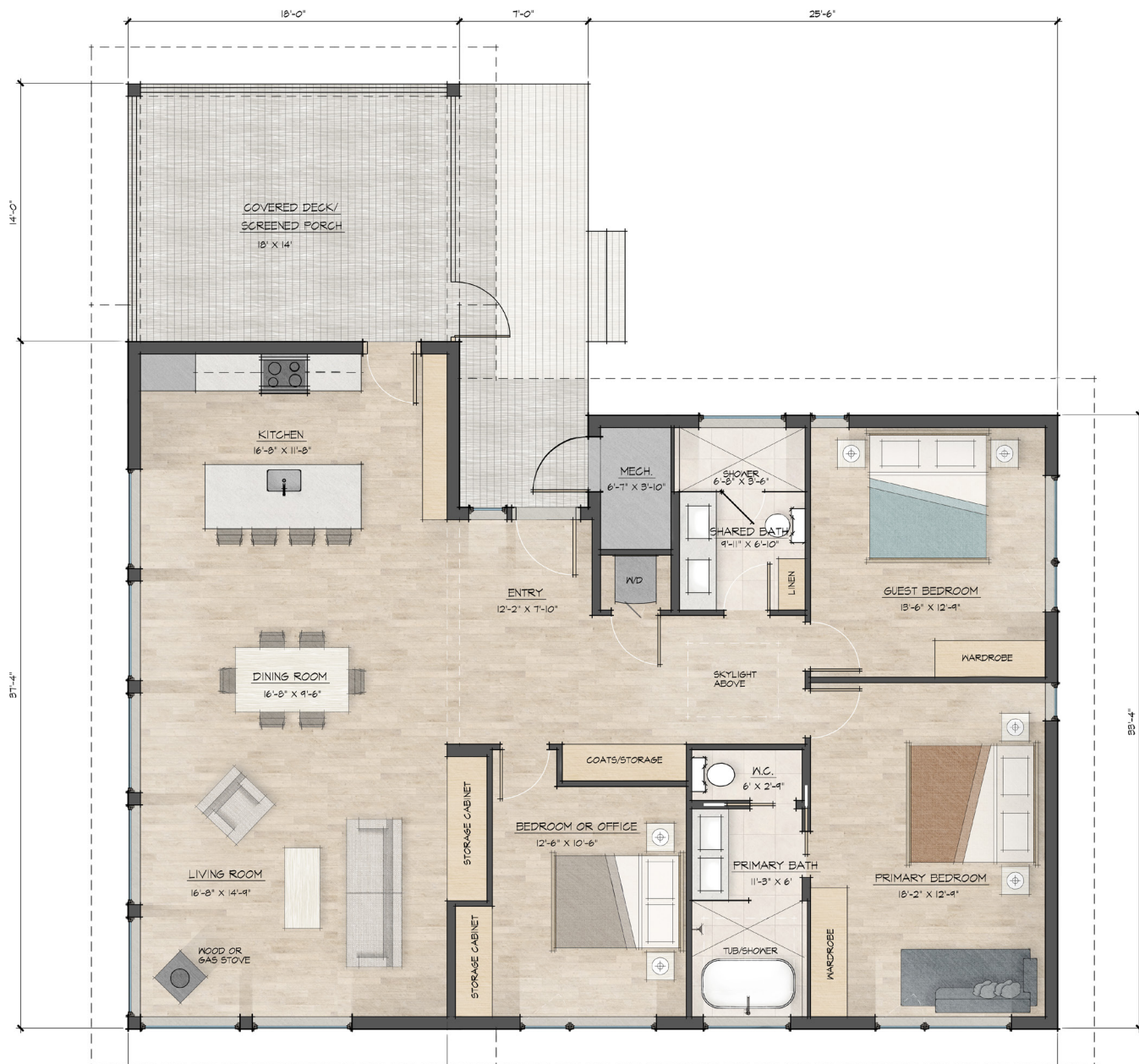
NAANTALI 160

Named for a community in the Finnish archipelago, the word “Naantali” translates to “valley of grace” in English. Nestled between two coastal mountains, the simple elegance of NordHavn’s Naantali 160 is true to its meaning. Designed by Pluspuu® of Finland and adapted for a Maine lifestyle, NordHavn’s 3-bed, 2-bath Naantali is a sophisticated one-level layout with two perpendicular mono-pitch roofs and cathedral ceilings. It has a spacious interior layout that has been smartly organized to include dramatic open living spaces and high-end finishes, reflecting a modern Scandinavian design aesthetic. Naantali’s construction employs sustainable building practices and ecologically sourced materials.

Entering through its covered portico, the open, cabinet-lined foyer is located at the heart of the home facing a prominent glass wall that seamlessly disappears into the natural setting, reminiscent of a childhood tree house.

The large open living area and modern corner fireplace on one side and a spacious central dining area on the other form a warm and inviting living space. The space is joined by the large designer kitchen with eat-in island, premium paneled appliances, and custom cabinets. Just off the kitchen is a large, covered deck ideal for al fresco dining and lounging. The bedrooms are in a separate wing of the home accessed through a hallway away from the living area. To maximize privacy, two bedrooms are located at the end of the hall. The spacious primary bedroom is notable for its ensuite, spa-like bath with soaking tub, walk-in shower, floating double vanity, and heated floor and towel rack. A second bathroom is shared with the other bedrooms, one of which may also be used as an office or den, making this layout the most spacious, flexible, and family oriented.
